

Criteria for extraordinary panel

At extraordinary panel for HR Autism ERP 2018, the students under discussion **MUST** meet the criteria (EHCP and a primary need of Autism along with evidence of a cognitive ability generally in line with their peers (see checklist for notes)) and should have had all the compulsory information sent through. They will be discussed on a case by case basis with the decision made by the whole panel after hearing all the cases.

If there are more applications than places, decisions will be made dependent on:

(i) Complexity of need in the following areas:

- High Anxiety
- Sensory Needs
- Social vulnerability
- Social Communication skills

Triangulation of evidence from parental/pupil voice, school, ST for Autism/ EP and SALT

(ii) The impact on others in the setting. The group dynamics is important. Whilst it is accepted that any change will impact on the current pupils, there should be some consideration on relative impact when it comes to agreeing placements. The year group of applicants is likely to be of significance to ensure groups that work socially are the right peer group.

(iii) Request for a full time place will take precedence over requests for p/t places

At extraordinary panel for HR SLCN ERP 2018, the students under discussion **MUST** meet the criteria (EHCP/MSP and a **primary need of SLCN*** along with evidence of a cognitive ability generally in line with their peers (see checklist for notes)) and should have had all the compulsory information sent through. They will be discussed on a case by case basis with the decision made by the whole panel after hearing all the cases.

If there are more applications than places, decisions will be made dependent on:

(i) Complexity of need

(ii) Evidence and recommendation from Outreach observation

(iii) Evidence and recommendation from SALT (and EP where appropriate)

***SAL report MUST indicate SAL disorder or impairment rather than delay. EP should have confirmed SLCN is the main barrier to learning**

CYP whose application is unsuccessful – consideration must be given at the meeting to the wording of the responses to parents in these cases

CYP whose application is successful – ERP banding to be used as part of the transition process (ERP Lead and primary school) to be reviewed prior to Feb 2019
