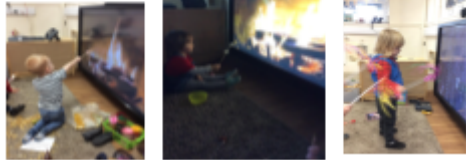


Tiny Steps
