We have been sharing mixed up fairytales and designing our own after reading 'The Great Fairytale Disaster'. We wrote our own fairytale books too!



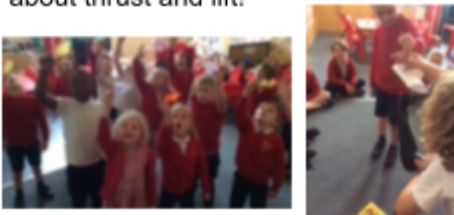
Nessgate:

This week year 6 have made mince beef pasties. This was another of their chosen recipes.



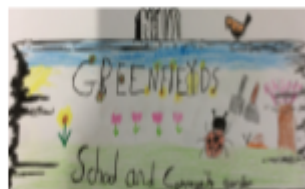
Fishergate:
