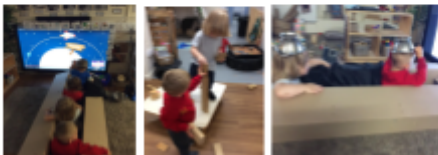


### Tiny Steps
