Plan for September 2021

As you know, the government ended the national Covid restrictions on the 19th July. This included the lifting of restrictions in education settings. The main changes affecting schools are:

- Contact tracing within schools will end
- Bubbles will no longer be required
- Staggered start and finish times will end
- Children under 18 will no longer be required to self-isolate if they are a contact of a positive case

Protective measures in schools will remain in place for at least the autumn term, including: practicing good hygiene; maintaining appropriate cleaning regimes; keeping classrooms, offices and communal areas well ventilated and twice weekly LFD testing for staff. We will also be updating all of our school risk assessments for September and will review these regularly throughout the autumn term.
